1.5 Retention period

We will not process personal data for as long as there is a contract in place to do so. We are subject to retain data for 7 years for historical reference and to be able to defend future HMRC enquiries should they arise.

1.6 Security

1.7 Your rights as a data subject

At any point while we are in possession of or processing your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- Right of access

- Right to object to automated processing, including profiling
- Right to judicial review: in the event that we refuse your request under rights of access, we will provide you with a reason as to why. You have the right to complain, as outline in clause 1.8 below.
